- Work toward developing trust with my Life Coach
- Be honest and open with my Life Coach
- Be faithful to commitments made with my Life Coach
- Communicate struggles and temptations with my Life Coach when they first surface
- Work hard to complete my *Transition Plan*
- Participate and serve in the local church
- Apply Biblical principles to my life
