Program Description:

“Transition Coach Training” is a training seminar for those who volunteer or wish to volunteer in mentoring inmates, particularly those who are recently released. This seminar requires a minimum of **six hours** to complete. Topics covered included in the seminar include:

- Foundations of Transition Coaching
- Transitioning Out of Poverty
- Motivational Interviewing
