

TRANSPORTATION TO WHEATON'S CAMPUS FROM CHICAGO:

Car: From the north or south: Take the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) to the East-West Tollway (I-88); take the East-West Tollway west and exit at Naperville Road. Take Naperville Road north to Roosevelt Road (Route 38). Turn right onto Roosevelt Road and then take the second left turn onto Chase Street. Take Chase Street north to College Avenue and the Billy Graham Center will be on your left.

From the east (Chicago): Take the Eisenhower Expressway to I-88 and follow directions above.

From the west: Approach Chicago on I-88 and then follow directions above.

From O'Hare Airport: From the airport, take I-190 East toward Chicago. From I-190 exit onto I-294 South (Tri-State Tollway). Then follow the directions from the north listed above.

Plane: We recommend using one of the following services to provide transportation from either O'Hare or Midway Airports.

Airtran-O'Hare - Service is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by calling 1-800-851-0200 either in Illinois or out of state. You may request either limo or van service (rates are slightly higher for limo). Reservations must be made one day in advance. Upon arrival at the airport, call for pickup at 1-800-851-0200.

West Suburban Travelers Limousine - In Illinois call (630) 668-9600, out of state call 1-800-345-5466 to schedule service from the airport to Wheaton College. Service provided 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, by reservation only. Prefer 24 hour notice for reservations, changes, or cancellations. At the airport, please call 1-800-942-5466 for pickup.

Train: If you are coming into Chicago's Union Station at 547 W. Jackson Blvd., you will need to walk two blocks to the Metra Station, 500 W. Madison (corner of Madison and Canal Streets). At the Metra Station, take the Chicago to Geneva line and exit the train at the College Avenue Station in Wheaton. From the Station, walk three blocks west to the Billy Graham Center.
